

Torah 1st Society – Statement of Beliefs

(subject to change as more light is given)

1. We believe Ahashua was created by AHYH, pre-existing before the material world.
2. We believe Ahashua was incarnate in a regular flesh and blood human.
3. We believe He is the fulfillment of Deuteronomy 18:18-20.
4. We believe He came to correctly interpret the written Torah, not abolish it as it unequivocally states in Matthew 5:17-20.

6. We believe as Paul prophesied in Acts 20:26-35, that the original "faith" has been polluted with false doctrine whereby people have "turned the grace of AHYH into lasciviousness" (literally means without law/Torah).
7. We believe satan (not being bound with mortality) has systematically infiltrated the "church". We believe he is a highly intelligent being that has incrementally hi-jacked the original "faith" and perverted it into the mess it is today. As the scriptures say satan deceives the whole world.
8. We believe that we are in the "last days" and that AHYH is calling His people "out of Babylon" which are the mystery religions of sun-worship, involving a trinity and pagan rituals.
9. We believe "christianity" today is best described as Laodicean. Christianity is sure that they have the whole truth, so self-assured that they have no clue that "thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked".
10. We believe that a great number of people have not put as much thought into their theology as into purchasing a new automobile. 11. 18. We believe people need to realize that all the peculiar things that Hebrews do emanate from the Father, they did not make them up, I am not speaking about moderns Jews, they made some of their stuff up.

Torah 1st Society - Prohibitions

The following activities or behaviors shall be considered violations of this Society and cause for dismissal:

Fornication/Adultery:

Fornication/Adultery is defined as any sexual activity or conduct outside of a marriage or long-term monogamous commitment.

Abortion:

Abortion shall be defined as the deliberate termination of the life of a child after fertilization by any means, or the use of abortifacient birth control chemicals or devices.

Assault against a party or child of this agreement:

Dangerous behavior shall be defined as one party's willful participation in behavior that has not been agreed upon by all parties that subjects the other party and/or the household to physical danger.
